Excalibur Function Keys & Screen Options

RED OPTIONS BAR The Red Options Bar at the bottom of every screen lists the valid commands. Enter is field accept / Ctrl Enter is save and proceed.

F1 / Context Sensitive Help Press F1 twice for the Help Index. Press G from Help Index, for Glossary of Terms and Glossary of System Message Definitions.

F2 / Input Control Screen Displays the status of all Inputs and provides full control over each one. F2 = Arm, F3 = Bypass, F4 = Follow Time Zone, F5 = All, F6 = Time Zone Data, F10 = Graphics

F3 / Device Communication Status Displays the polling status of each panel. White = Polling, Red = Not Polling The **Firmware Version** of each panel is displayed to the right of the device number. F2 = Device Info - RAM size and hardware revision.

F4 / Panel Download Status Screen Displays the Master panel downloading to all Slave panels. This is subsequent to the PC downloading to the Master Panel. *0 = Panel Download Complete

F5 / Phone List Emergency phone number list.

F6 / Search a Code Search "All Codes In or Out", just "In" or just "Out" or "Last Used" at a particular door. Searches can be performed by Name or Code.

F7 / Operator Comment Comments can be made anytime and will be permanently recorded into history. Comments can be a Shift Change or Incident Report. Comment length is unlimited.

F8 / Alarm Screen. The Alarm Screen is where Alarms can be acknowledged and resolved and Graphic Maps can be viewed. F5 = Phone list, F10 = Map

F9 / Output Screen. The Output Control Screen provides control and shows the status of each relay or door output. F2 = Open, F3 = Secure, F4 = Follow Time Zone, F5 = All, F6 = Time Zone Data, F7 = Grant Access, F10 = Map

F10 / Remote Status. Reports the memory configuration and Event Buffer Size. **WI823 6/96**

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
